Brilla Soccer Ministries was founded in 1996 on a soccer mission trip to Costa Rica. Brilla's purpose is to share the good news of Jesus Christ through the game of soccer. Whether in a foreign country, playing in the states, or in a camp setting, our goal remains the same – to shine for Jesus. Brilla is the Spanish word for “shine,” which reminds us that Jesus said, “Let your light shine before men.” (Matthew 5:16) Since its inception over ten years ago, Brilla has expanded its ministry into three main areas:

Teams

Mississippi Brilla FC is the highest level of soccer in the state of Mississippi with its Premier Development League Franchise. It offers aspiring professional soccer players the opportunity to further their careers and progress through the professional ranks. Brilla's amateur team competes throughout the year all over the country in friendly matches and tournaments. The team competes against college teams, youth and men's teams, or other exhibition squads.

Camps

Throughout the summer, Brilla's staff can be found teaching soccer to children in week-long camps hosted by churches throughout the country. The goal of Brilla's soccer camp is to share the love of Jesus with as many kids as possible, while providing fun, challenging, and high-quality training in the game of soccer.

Youth Training Academy Registration

Purpose: Mississippi Brilla FC has created a beneficial developmental youth training academy. The goal is to provide additional training and competition for age groups U6-U12 following the spring season. The training sessions will be conducted once a week on a designated day and will compete in a 3-a-side format on May 8th & 15th. Trainers will be provided by MS Brilla FC and will be fully responsible for the development of the players involved. The trainers will be expected to develop each player physically, technically, and mentally, but most importantly should promote fun.



Club Benefits: This academy is not only to promote individual development but club development. It is important to our club that we stand out from our competitors and offer something new and different in the metro area. This opportunity will be open to all youth players in the area, which will help bring recognition to our organization. This will also take place before the club tryouts, and will encourage more and different players to join our organization. We hope that the implementation of this program will create an atmosphere that will continue to involve willing and eager players that find development important.

How it will work: Players will register online at any time, and on-site, if necessary, on April 27th. Each player will be placed in a training pool based on age or ability. Trainers will proceed with an hour session once a week and will organize the competition day on designated Saturdays. Each week will bring different challenges to the players by way of introducing new topics to train. Mississippi Brilla FC will be responsible for training topics and all organizational aspects.

Training Sessions will take place each Tuesday from 6:00 - 7:00.
3 v 3 games will take place on May 8 & May 15th at 10:00 AM.
